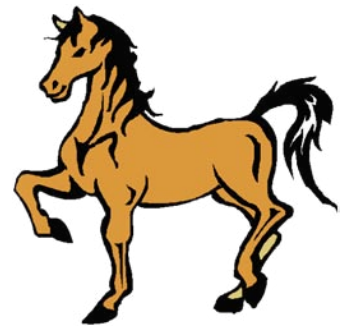

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. No refunds on entries. If less than five entries, a lot may be cancelled or combined.
2. Judge's or show committee's decision will be final.
3. Show committee reserves the right to request cash entry fee.
4. Negative Coggins test required on all equine (horses, ponies, mules, etc). Out-of-state equine must also be accompanied by an IL State Entry Permit and a Health Certificate.
(Permits are free and are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week by calling 217.782.4944.)
5. Adult attendant at all times with stallions.
6. No stallions may be shown by a youth. (19 & Under)
7. All ponies are 14.2 & under
8. Rider's age is as of Jan 1, 2010.
9. All exhibitors and/or parents and guests will be required to have either a daily pass or season pass to enter the fairgrounds & horse arena area.
10. The McHenry County Fair will not be responsible for accidents, bodily injury or theft.
NO PETS, LIQUOR, BIKES, SKATEBOARDS OR ROLLERBLADES ALLOWED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS.
11. **"WARNING: Under the Equine Activity Liability Act, each participant who engages in an equine activity expressly assumes the risks of engaging in and legal responsibility for injury, loss or damage to person or property resulting from the risk of equine activities."**

TRADITIONAL TYPE HORSE DESCRIPTION

CLASS 19 (SATURDAY): THE ENGLISH CLASSES ARE SPLIT INTO TWO DIFFERENT STYLES. TRADITIONAL STYLE WHICH WOULD BE FOR THE HUNTER/JUMPER, AMERICAN SADDLEBRED, ARABIAN AND MORGAN TYPES (HORSES THAT MOVE WITH A HIGHER HEADSET). STOCK-TYPE IS MORE FOR QUARTER HORSE, APPALOOSA AND PAINT TYPES (HORSES THAT RIDE WITH A MORE LEVEL HEADSET). YOUR STYLE MAY NOT BE DECIDED BY YOUR BREED, WAY OF GOING SHOULD BE CONSIDERED. THE SAME RIDER/HORSE COMBINATION MAY NOT APPEAR IN BOTH TRADITIONAL AND STOCK PLEASURE CLASSES.

YOUTH SHOW CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

CLASS 18: TANDEM BAREBACK SWITCH – THIS CLASS IS RUN AS A PLEASURE CLASS (ENGLISH OR WESTERN).

RIDERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SWITCH PLACES WITHOUT TOUCHING THE GROUND.

CLASS 19: DOLLAR BAREBACK – COMPETITORS BRING THEIR OWN DOLLAR BILL TO THE GATE. JUDGE WILL PLACE THE DOLLAR. THIS CLASS IS RUN AS A COMMAND CLASS. THE LAST RIDER TO LOSE HIS/HER DOLLAR WINS ALL THE DOLLARS IN ADDITION TO THE PREMIUM PAID. NO CHAPS ALLOWED.

CLASS 20 & 21: COSTUME – HANDLERS ALLOWED BUT SHOULD NOT BE PART OF COSTUME.

CLASS 22: GOAT TAIL TYING: COMPETITORS RIDE TO THE OPPOSITE END OF THE ARENA, DISMOUNT THEIR HORSE/PONY, A RING CREW MEMBER WILL HOLD YOUR HORSE WHILE YOU CATCH THE GOAT AND RIDER MUST TIE A RIBBON AROUND ON ITS TAIL. RIDER WILL REMOUNT THEIR HORSE AND CROSS THE FINISH LINE. THE RIBBON MUST STAY ON THE GOAT'S TAIL UNTIL THE RIDER CROSSES THE FINISH LINE. RIBBON FALLING OFF EARLY WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.

CLASS 23: TIMED OBSTACLE – THE CONTESTANT IS TO CROSS A BRIDGE; OPEN, RIDE THROUGH AND CLOSE A GATE; PLACE MAIL IN MAILBOX; BACK UP BETWEEN TWO BARRELS AND NEGOTIATE A JUMP. THE CONTESTANT IS DISQUALIFIED FOR FAILING TO COMPLETE ANY OF THE OBSTACLES OR FOR KNOCKING DOWN AN OBSTACLE BEFORE IT IS COMPLETED.

CLASS 24 & 24: EGG & SPOON – THIS CLASS IS RUN AS A COMMAND CLASS. EACH ENTRY WILL RECEIVE A SPOON AND AN EGG. RIDERS WILL HOLD THE SPOON AT THE LOCATION MARKED ON THE HANDLE. RIDER CANNOT TOUCH THE EGG. THE RIDER WHO RETAINS THE EGG ON THE END OF THE SPOON THE LONGEST IS THE WINNER.

CLASS 26 & 27: WATER GUN RACE – THIS IS A TIMED EVENT. RIDER WILL BE GIVEN A WATER GUN UPON ENTERING THE ARENA. RIDER WEAVES THROUGH PATTERN SHOOTING AT THREE TARGETS AND THEN BACK ACROSS THE FINISH LINE.

SPEED CLASS REGULATIONS: FIVE SECOND PENALTY FOR KNOCKED POLES OR BARREL IN ALL CLASSES. NO TIMES FOR MISSED PICK-UP OR MISSED PLACEMENT OF FLAG OR DROPPED FLAG **IN CLASSES 32 & 33.** NO TIME FOR GOING OFF PATTERN IN ALL CLASSES. EXCESSIVE USE OF SPURS OR WHIP WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.
